To the Honorable Seth Lewis, Judge of the District court in and for the Parish of St. Martin.

The petition of Lucy Carr, alias Lucy McLaughlin, wife of James McLaughlin of the Parish of St. Martin with respect, represents that about seven years ago, she was lawfully married to James McLaughlin & that for some time, she derived from the marriage connection the happiness she had in view in forming it.

But your Petitioner begs leave to state that for three or four years past, Mr. McLaughlin has given himself up to continuous dissipation;

- that a constant and habitual state of intoxication, has rendered him morose & quarrelsome - that he has often insulted, beat and abused your petitioner.

- that his whole conduct, his excesses, vile treatment, and outrages are such as to render the life of your petitioner, as the wife of McLaughlin, wretched and insupportable.

- your petitioner further represents that she has three small children by Mr. McLaughlin, the oldest of which is only five years old, that they are at present and have been for sometime past, wholly supported by the labor and exertions of your petitioner.

- that your petitioner has been obliged to abandon the house of her husband, and take up a temporary residence with her brother, where herself and children now are.

- that your petitioner and her marriage with Mr. McLaughlin and since various articles of paraphernalia property from her mother, among which were hogs, five gentle cows & calves, besides other cattle, a part of which has been squandered and dissipated by her husband, that a tract of land of four (illegible) front with the ordinary depth, lying

upon the Grass Isle (illegible) in the said Parish of St. Martin bounded above by William Carr & below by Levi Campbell, was purchased by Mr. McLaughlin since your petitioner's marriage with him, which was paid for by your petitioner's mother, though the deed may have been given directly to her husband and that the price of the land was (illegible) upon the amount coming to your petitioner out of her deceased fathers estate - that Mr. McLaughlin has already contrary to the expectations and request of your petitioner, sold many articles belonging exclusively to her, among which is a

yoke of work oxen, worth eighty dollars and that Mr. James McLaughlin threatens to sell the land as soon as he can find a purchaser - these provisions considered, your petitioner therefore prays that the Mr. James McLaughlin may be duly cited to appear before your Honorable Court to answer to the foregoing petition, and that your petitioner may be legally separated, as well in property as in bed & board from him, and that all her matrimonial rights may be restored - she also prays that the house of her brother, William Carr may be assigned as her domicile during the continuation of this suit and that she may be permitted to retain in her possession her three children - your petitioner further prays that the Mr. James McLaughlin may provisionally & definitively be inhibited & enjoined from intimidating or interfering with your petitioner or her children or her property that he may be officially inhibited and enjoined from selling the tracts of land & that on the final hearing of this case the written title of the same, if any, that Mr. McLaughlin has may deeded to insure to the benefit of your petitioner & that she may be restored to the property & (illegible) of the same - your petitioner prays that the defendant may pay the cost of this suit, & also she prays for what other relief as equity & justice demand.

BAGGETT, W.J. (1907), Milam, Milano, age 65 on 20th of Feb 1907, lived in Milano about 15 months. Applied once at Ballinger, but never heard from it. Farmer, not able to work, some nervous trouble, exposure and general debility of age. Command organized in NC, enlisted about July 1856, 1861, discharged at surrender in 1865, Co A, 31st NC Infantry. Owns nothing. I owned a home worth about \$600 in Ballinger but

I owed about \$300 and had to sell it to pay the debt. Wife has no property in own right. Receives no income, unable to earn a support; never deserted, has lived in TX since before 1 Jan 1880. Signed W.J. Baggett, 24 Jan 1906.

Of the 1,620 whom we knew died, there were over 200 not identified, and their names were not on the Remembrance Wall. Recently, in going through the records of the 31st, I found that Pvt Gaines' name was not on the wall. We have taken steps to place his name on that wall along with a number of others whom we just learned had been left off the list supplied to us.

Notes for JUDY LUJEAN WRIGHT:

Judy died at 3 P.M. on September 11, 1996 in her home in Wichita Falls, TX. She died as a result of ovarian cancer which was first discovered in August 1995 when she had surgery pursuant to the doctor finding large, hard growths during a pelvic exam. After the surgery, she underwent seven months of chemo. Every third Friday she would enter the hospital and be infused with "rat poison" (as she referred to it).

For the following week she would be very ill, during the second week she would begin to feel human, and during the third week, she was able to go into her office and perform some work on a limited basis. Then it was back to the hospital on Friday for the entire thing to begin anew. Seven months of this torture.

At the conclusion of the chemo she was re-examined and the doctor decided that he needed to operate and have a "look" inside to see what was happening, as Judy was having terrible stomach pains and couldn't seem to pass any feces.

On May 24, 1996 she was operated on in the Wichita Falls General Hospital. After the operation the surgeon came into the waiting room and announced to the family that the cancer had spread and there were several organs involved. His parting comment was, "take her home and give her some quality time."

She was discharged from the hospital about 10 days later and returned to her home on Sherman St. Her daughter, Marisa and her two children, Hayley and Megan moved in with Judy to care for her until her death.

On the day of her death, the hospice home health care worker had just completed

giving Judy her daily bath and had moved Judy from the bed to a chair where the worker gave Judy a foot massage and rubbed oil into her legs.

Suddenly, Judy's legs began to spasm, she took three deep breaths, and died. In the room were, Marisa, Ethelene Fox (her mother) and the health care worker. When Judy began to be distressed, Ethelene (knowing what was happening no doubt) told Marisa that she would go into the other room to see that Megan didn't enter the living room to see Judy in this condition.

An hour later the prearranged funeral home arrived and removed the body. The body was taken to Lawton, OK where she was cremated. Her cremains were returned to Marisa one day later.

There was a memorial service conducted at the Hospice facility in Wichita Falls at 7:00 P.M. on Monday, September 16, 1996. Judy had ask that there be no flowers and any remembrance should be directed to the Wichita Falls Hospice people. (Marisa did provide a small vase of flowers to be displayed along side a blown-up picture of Judy and her two grandchildren, Hayley and Megan).

The cremains are in the custody of Marisa Ballard (Judy's daughter). Marisa said she had plans to bury the container in the flower garden at her home Malenkof, TX and if she should move she plans to dig them up and move them with her to her next home's flower garden.

Judy was 49 years of age on her death, much to young!
