Hello Lynn,

I believe the Will was probated in Shelby Co IL but John died in Taney Co MO....

I think that is the reason why the Will was not probated/finalized until much later.

He was in the 1850 Taney Co MO Census and not the 1860...so he died somewhere in between.

The bio in the book, goes on to say that Leonard S. (Len) & wife were the only one

to bring his family...so, I think that John (b. 1776)'s children (Leonard's brother & sisters) did not follow them to Missouri.

We have no proof that Priscilla, his wife came with him to Missouri either since she is not in the 1850 Census.

According to <http://www.edenmartin.com/counties/rose.htm/>

Rose Township (Shelby County) bounded on the north by Ridge Township. John Moseley is supposed to be the first settler. He located in the north-west part of what is now Rose, as early as 1824; was a native of Tennessee when he came to Shelby Co. He was quite an old man, and had a family grown. He afterwards moved to Missouri.

[Marilyn's comment: He may have lived in Tennessee before coming to Illinois, we know that he was born in SC; his son Leonard S. was b. in KY].

[This is the beginning of the Reminiscent History of the Ozark Region]....keep in mind, the subject of this bio is the grandson of John b. 1776, and brother to Easton].....

"JOHN MOSELEY, who since 1840 has been a resident of this county, is a man highly esteemed by all and one whose career has been upright and honorable in every particular. He was born in Shelby County, Ill., March 14, 1825, and is a son of Len S. and Elizabeth (Whitten) Moseley. The elder Moseley was a native of the blue grass regions of Kentucky, where his parents, John and Priscilla Moseley, were among the pioneers. They came originally from South Carolina. At an early date Grandfather Moseley moved to Missouri and first settled on White River. Later he settled on Beaver Creek, where his death occurred many years ago. He reared a large family, .."

John (b. 1776) died some time after this 1850 Census was taken on Aug 22, 1850 in Taney County, Missouri.

[Marilyn's comment- wonder when John's Will was made out, before he died or as a result of the probate Court?]

According to research done by Dan Ratliff:

He died without a will, and supposedly over twelve years his estate was tied up in the courts. There were numerous administrators over the years that were appointed by the court to handle his estate.

The first appointee was his son-in-law (husband of Elizabeth) Lindsay McMorris. He held the position until Dec 1857 when he resigned. John Howard, also his son-in-law, and husband of Eurena, was next appointed as the Administrator in Dec 1857,

John's personal property was sold on March 21, 1857 with a listing of the bills of sales. Spencer Co IL, Will Book # 5, pg 509, Jan 4, 1858 AD.

On December 1869, a final settlement was made by Marshall Howard, apparently the son of John and Eurena Howard.

It is believed the estate was divided among what are believed to be his children which are named in the settlement, however their relationship is not confirmed in these documents.

[All of the census' states that John b. 1776 was born in South Carolina and Leonard S. born in KY].

These articles appeared in the Taney County Times, Oct 4, 1888.

Quite a lively battle was witnessed near the (Forsyth) Square Wednesday evening in which Easton Moseley & William Morgan were the Belligerents. A perfect shower of stones were thrown by both parties but neither was seriously hurt. A woman was said to have been at the bottom of the fracas.

This article appeared in Taney County Times, Oct 11, 1888  
Easton Moseley got a divorce from Susan Orr and the late Mrs. Moseley became Mrs. Wm. Morgan forthwith.

This article appeared in Taney County Times, Mar 20, 1890  
Mrs. Wm. Morgan who lived on Beaver Creek, died last Sunday of la grippe (flu). Dr. Johnson was called to see her but she was in a dying condition when he reached her and beyond the aid of a physician.

This article appeared in Taney County Times, Mar 27, 1890  
An inquest was held last week over the body of Mrs. Morgan, the wife of William Morgan, who lived four miles north of this place (Taneyville). The lady died some two weeks ago and the physician who was called in a short time before her death, pronounced her poisoned and the coroner summoned a jury and the body was disinterred and her stomach examined by Drs. Johnson of Forsyth and Williams of Cedar Creek, who found evidence of poison in the shape of holes, etc.

It is supposed a warrant has been issued for Morgan's arrest. At least he and a girl, who it was said was very intimate with him, and who by the way, was the daughter of his wife by a former husband, skipped out on last Friday night, while it was raining.

(There is no further mention of this incident in future editions of the newspaper, which ceased publishing within a year of this issue and the court records in Taney County have nothing on this matter. This shall remain a mystery to me.)

So..... Nathan left the army in 1865, married Rhoda Barnes in Douglas County on Sept 4, 1886 - (I find her in the 1860 Taney Co census, living with her presumed mother, Sarah b: ca 1805, and Rhoda's two younger brothers). Nathan & Rhoda then had three children, all born in Missouri, then moved to Kansas when the youngest was about a year old.

Did Rhoda die in Douglas Co., Kansas in ca 1870? She must have, because in the 1870 census their youngest child, Lewis Nathan is one year old on his last birthday and he says he was born in Missouri. So between his birth in '69 and the taking of the '70 census, they relocated to Kansas.

Nathan returned to Missouri, because in 1871 he married his #2 wife, Elmina Caroline Stanley in Taney Co., MO, where they would have one daughter, Effie Jane. Then Elmina dies on Oct 2, 1876.

Then in 1879 he marries his #3 wife, Mary Elizabeth Moseley in Taney Co., MO, where they have two sons; Charles Easton (my grandfather) & James Curtis.

Both Nathan and Mary Elizabeth die in 1887.

Whew!

Now the strange part.... Nathan's brother James Curtis, was also married to a woman named Rhoda who lived and died about the same years as Nathan's Rhoda. James Curtis & Rhoda are buried in Bradleyville (Missouri) Cemetery and this Rhoda has a birth date of Feb 7, 1841, and a death date of Apr 15, 1869. This is a huge cemetery, with thousands of graves. The office will provide a map of the cemetery and will mark the grave site for you.

Judy died at 3 P.M. on September 11, 1996 in her home in Wichita Falls, TX. She died as a result of ovarian cancer which was first discovered in August 1995 when she had surgery pursuant to the doctor finding large, hard growths during a pelvic exam. After the surgery, she underwent seven months of chemo. Every third Friday she would enter the hospital and be infused with "rat poison" (as she referred to it).

For the following week she would be very ill, during the second week she would begin to feel human, and during the third week, she was able to go into her office and perform some work on a limited basis. Then it was back to the hospital on Friday for the entire thing to begin anew. Seven months of this torture.

At the conclusion of the chemo she was re-examined and the doctor decided that he needed to operate and have a "look" inside to see what was happening, as Judy was having terrible stomach pains and couldn't seem to pass any feces.

On May 24, 1996 she was operated on in the Wichita Falls General Hospital. After the operation the surgeon came into the waiting room and announced to the family that the cancer had spread and there were several organs involved. His parting comment was, "take her home and give her some quality time."

She was discharged from the hospital about 10 days later and returned to her home on Sherman St. Her daughter, Marisa and her two children, Hayley and Megan moved in with Judy to care for her until her death.

On the day of her death, the hospice home health care worker had just completed giving Judy her daily bath and had moved Judy from the bed to a chair where the worker gave Judy a foot massage and rubbed oil into her legs.

Suddenly, Judy's legs began to spasm, she took three deep breaths, and died. In the room were, Marisa, Ethelene Fox (her mother) and the health care worker. When Judy began to be distressed, Ethelene (knowing what was happening no doubt) told Marisa that she would go into the other room to see that Megan didn't enter the living room to see Judy in this condition.

An hour later the prearranged funeral home arrived and removed the body. The body was taken to Lawton, OK where she was cremated. Her cremains were returned to Marisa one day later.

There was a memorial service conducted at the Hospice facility in Wichita Falls at 7:00 P.M. on Monday, September 16, 1996. Judy had ask that there be no flowers and any remembrance should be directed to the Wichita Falls Hospice people.

(Marisa did provide a small vase of flowers to be displayed along side a blown-up picture of Judy and her two grandchildren, Hayley and Megan).

The cremains are in the custody of Marisa Ballard (Judy's daughter). Marisa said she had plans to bury the container in the flower garden at her home Malenkof, TX and if she should move she plans to dig them up and move them with her to her next home's flower garden.

Judy was 49 years of age on her death, much to young!
